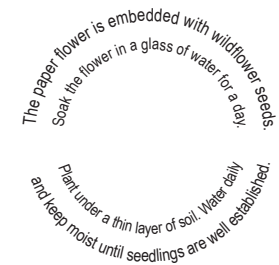
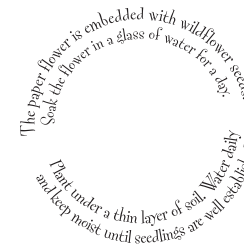


This card is embedded with wildflower seeds. Soak in water overnight. Cover with a thin layer of soil and keep moist until seedlings are established.

The handmade paper is embedded with annual and perennial wildflower seeds. Soak the paper in water overnight. Cover with a thin layer of soil and keep evenly moist until seedlings are established. Sprouts will appear in a week or two.

Plant this seeded paper and watch your wildflower garden grow - a little reminder that beauty surrounds us every day. Take time to enjoy it.



This card is embedded with wildflower seeds. Soak the paper in water overnight. Cover with a thin layer of soil outside and keep moist until seedlings are well established.

The **seeded paper house** is embedded with a few annual and perennial **wildflower** seeds. **Soak** the house **in** a bowl of **water** for a day, then plant under a **thin layer** of loose **soil**. **Water daily** and keep moist until seedlings are well established. Germination time is **1-4 weeks**.

The **seeded paper** is embedded with a handful of annual and perennial **wildflower** seeds. Plant under 1/4 inch of loose, well drained soil. **Water twice daily** and keep moist until seedlings are well established. Germination time is **1-4 weeks**.



The **handmade** paper is embedded with annual and perennial **wildflower** seeds. Soak the paper in **water** overnight. Cover with a thin layer of soil and **keep moist** until seedlings are well established. **Sprouts** will appear in a **week** or two.

The handmade paper is embedded with a hearty mix of annual and perennial wildflower seeds. Plant under a thin layer of soil and water thoroughly. Keep moist until seedlings are well established.

This paper is embedded with a handful of annual and perennial wildflower seeds. Soak the paper in water overnight. Cover with a thin layer of soil. Keep evenly moist until seedlings are established. Sprouts will appear in a week or two.

This paper is embedded with a handful of annual and perennial wildflower seeds. Soak the paper in water overnight. Cover with a thin layer of soil and keep moist until seedlings are established.

To grow wildflowers from this tag, place under 1/4 inch of loose soil and keep moist.
